There will several excursions every day on various themes during the Festival.

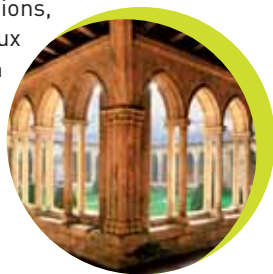
These include:

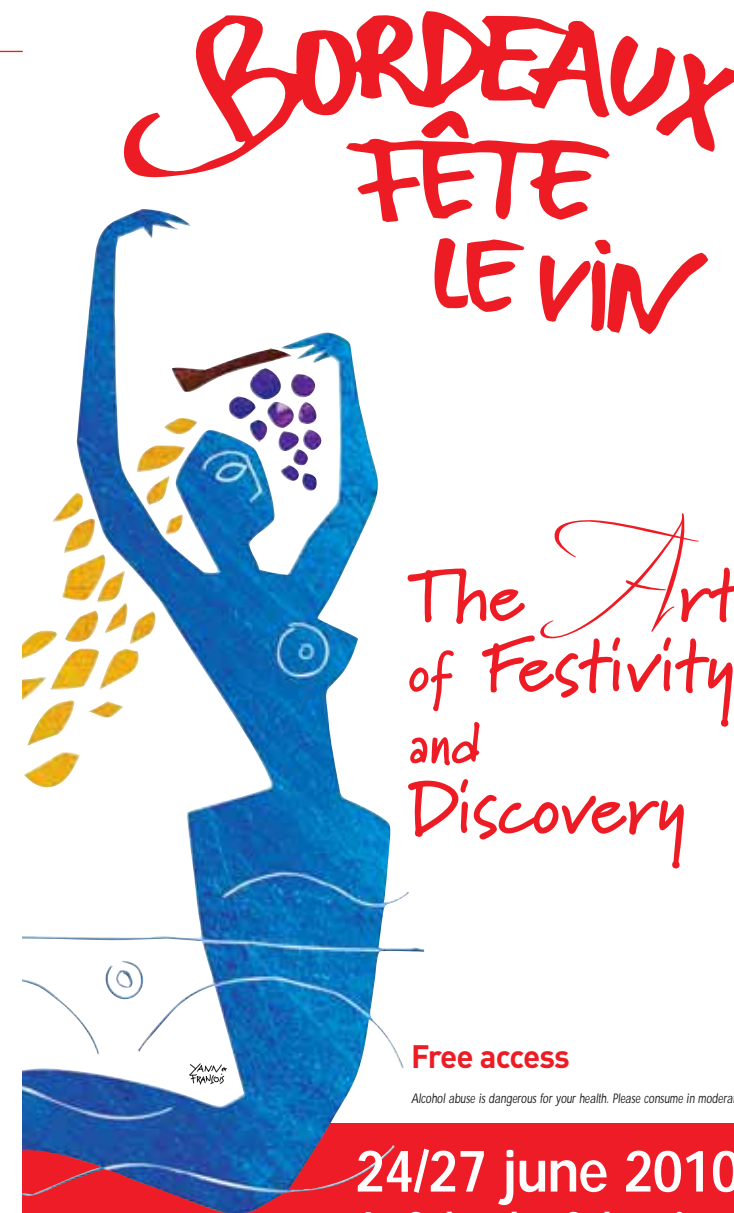

# The Art of Festivity and Discovery

Lovers of wine, food, celebration, and culture are cordially invited to enjoy the wonderful atmosphere of the Bordeaux Wine Festival. Visitors can also take advantage of an outstanding programme to discover the architectural beauty of Bordeaux (listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO), its cultural assets and surrounding vineyards, as well as the many attractions of the Aquitaine region.

## ► Quebec City, guest of honour

The seventh Bordeaux Wine Festival will be paying tribute to Bordeaux's francophone twin city, Québec, with a series of special events and shows.

Furthermore there will be a special pavilion devoted to this North American city.



## ► A 2 km "wine road" along the riverbank, across from beautiful 18<sup>th</sup> century buildings

Pavilions featuring the wines of Bordeaux and Bordeaux Supérieur, the Côtes de Bordeaux, Saint-Emilion-Pomerol-Fronsac, the Médoc and Graves, dry white Bordeaux, sweet Bordeaux, leading branded Bordeaux, and Aquitaine will form a 2 km wine road on the banks of the Garonne.

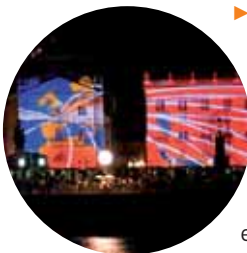
It will be possible to taste the wines of some 80 Bordeaux and Aquitaine appellations (from both producers and négociants), as well as local gastronomic specialties from 11 am to midnight.

## ► Entertainment & special events

There will be numerous special events open to the public during the 4-day Bordeaux Wine Festival. These include wine master classes, a barrel rolling competition, parades of vinous brotherhoods, and a large Banquet de Bacchus (the god of wine). In addition, there will be guided vineyard tours every day leaving from the Festival.

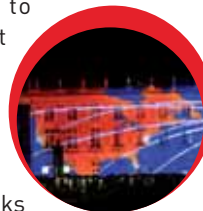


## ► Four nights of celebration



The Place de Bourse and various locations along the river will play host to a variety of performances featuring live music, a firework display, and sound and light shows. Each evening, some 60,000 people are expected to enjoy the entertainment and fantastic atmosphere at

the Bordeaux Wine Festival!



## ► Your stay in Bordeaux

At 15 €, the pass includes 12 tasting vouchers, a tasting ticket, a glass and glass holder, as well as reductions and free gifts.
